Our topic this month is reclamation. Now reclamation can have several nuances and we may each take a unique view, yet we are all talking about reclamation. We are all talking about Mother Earth and we are all talking about humanity. So with that in mind, we will proceed.

Now normally when I have guest speakers, I get to say a few words and then the guest speakers come in and say a few words and then I get the final word. That is the normal procedure for ThoughtsFromAMaster.

This month, my words of opening have about concluded. I would like my guest speakers to have a little more time and I will come back at the end of this message and offer my opinion as well as my thank-you's to my guest speakers.

Our first speaker is Philohstan from the constellation Aquila. Philohstan, welcome.

I thank you, Master Yeshua. And I would say greetings and thank you to the readers of this website.

I have spoken here before and I have always been allowed to speak my thoughts, which is a very valued opportunity, particularly when we who are Allies get to speak to the human family of Earth. This month, however, not only am I allowed the privilege of speaking with you, my younger brothers

and sisters, but I am allowed to speak on a subject that is very near to my heart: reclamation.

If you have been following me, you know that I am, I suppose you could call it, a galactic traveler. I visit many cultures, many civilizations, and I have the privilege of learning much in my travels, learning about the differences and learning about the commonalities. I would say also learning about the common mistakes that are regretted by various civilizations and the commonalities in the ways of recovering from those – how shall I put it? – decisions that are regretted. We will not call them mistakes. We will call them decisions that are regretted.

And I will say that what I have learned is that when a civilization has decisions that have been made either de facto and knowingly or simply by default because there was truly no active deciding process, when a society or disabled civilization has decisions that they regret, they look back. They say, "We wish we had done things differently. We wish we had issued an intervention at such and such point in time. We wish we had prevented this particular outcome, and it could have been prevented if we had only done this or if we had only done that." But whatever it was that could have been done to prevent the result was not done and they ended up in a bit of a mess.

Now sometimes these messes have been very painful to face. Those that are most painful, I have found, are most articulately and precisely recorded in the civilization's history. They wish all future generations, all other members of the cosmic human family, to understand what it was they wrongly decided de facto or by default, what the consequences were, why they wish they had done something differently, so that everyone can learn from their experience. That is a commonality. And the other commonalities are the characteristics of the reclamation, the characteristics that are common as these members of the cosmic human family have recovered from decisions they wish they had made differently.

It is those decisions about reclamation, those commonalities about reclamation, that I would bring forward now.

One of the primary ... well, there are many primaries and I'm not certain they can be listed in order, but the following are included.

Creativity – creativity that is practiced in cooperation, one with another. This concerns factions who have been at odds, perhaps simply pointing fingers at one another for supposed negligence and responsibility for the mess – at any rate, factions who have not been friends, shall we say, or active partners in moving forward for the entire civilization. When these factions come together and brainstorm creatively in search of solutions that will pull

them out of the mess, the more they brainstorm, the more creativity blooms and blossoms. And the more creativity blooms, the more they discover they really do like one another and they really do have a great deal in common. So together, these factions who have not been working together now come together, each very pleased with the creative solution that they have developed together as equals, each respecting the other and the other's contribution to a creative way to reclaim the mess that has been made. And they move forward from there.

A second primary commonality is the recognition that each faction is part of the Oneness of the cosmic human family, and there is an equality that is and must be respected. It is sometimes a surprise to find that a faction who had been sidelined or disregarded, or thought too superior to be willing to talk or too inferior to be worth talking to, is indeed open to respectful conversation. The commonality comes with the recognition of what these factions have in common and when they start making that list of all they do have in common, the list suddenly grows longer and longer and then they begin, from that perspective, to recognize Oneness.

The third primary commonality is, I would call it, a vision of a better way than the mess they have found themselves in, a mess of their own making. They recognize this and they recognize that there is a vision of a better way of interacting, a better way of relating to one another, to the planet in which they live and to the other members of the cosmic human family. That which was focused inward on, we shall say, personal issues – whether that is a group working on the personal issues of its own, or if it is individual members of a group, or if it is, in fact, a full continent of the planet – each faction's scope was limited and bounded by personal issues, and each faction had different limits. Yet when they looked beyond the limits that they had become accustomed to, they discovered a better way.

Now the limits that they may have set and become accustomed to could have been quite broad. They might, for instance, have set limits at relationships with only the planets sharing the same star. Or those limits might have been broader, reaching to the planets of two stars relatively close. In one way or another, whatever those limits were, once they looked beyond them and began to consider the broader context of the cosmic human family, or perhaps simply a broader context than they had ever before considered, they found the wherewithal and the vision and the wisdom to move forward for the good of a greater whole than what they had previously been considering.

Those are the characteristics from my travels that I find with reclamation. They are much easier to describe in hindsight, when the difficult negotiations have been completed and the parties are rather excited about the way that they will move forward to meet this new vision than it is when the first

realization hits that one way or another, reclamation is necessary and cannot be avoided. Those are the most challenging times, the recognition of the necessity and the first steps in recognizing what kind of cooperation is going to be necessary in order to achieve the reclamation for the good of the whole. That is where the human family of Earth is right now, in those very difficult, very challenging beginning steps.

I would remind you that we are here. We who have been through these reclamation steps on our own or we would not have volunteered to come and assist, and we who have guided other civilizations through the same process. If I may be allowed, this is much like your organizations that deal with addiction and are organized so that those who have been through and recovered from the addiction are the ones who are working for the organization. They are the ones who are speaking to those who are addicts.

It is the same principle. We who are coming have been through this reclamation and we would, if you will allow, guide you as you go through a process that has been gone through many times throughout the cosmos. Success in Oneness is ever the outcome, but the steps to get there can be painful and very challenging. Yet everyone who has achieved the outcome agrees not only that was it worth it, but that things would have been better from the beginning had they not resisted each other and the process of working together. But that is another topic. I have said what I wish to say and I thank you very much for your attention.

Every time you get together with friends – be it for dinner, be it for the theater, be it simply to have a few drinks together and discuss a book – start this meeting by taking a few moments to see if you can agree as a small group of friends – or a large group of friends if you have a large group of friends gathering – take a few moments and agree together that you would like to reclaim the dark environment of this planet.

You can start by saying you would like to empty the energetic garbage from the location you are at, that you would like to clear this location of any shadows and bring in the brightest possible light. And the broader ring you put on that light – be it, for instance, the neighborhood where you are meeting – then the broader is the impact possible. If you could make that a habit, just taking a few moments to bring light to the environment in which you meet, and you can determine for yourselves how wide that environment would be, bring in light together and dissipate the darkness and the shadows and the garbage with that light that comes in.

This is a clearing, and if you would practice this clearing, locally, in your daily lives, it would be very useful for the entire reclamation of the energy of this planet.

Thank you, Sho. Thank you, very much.

I will spend a few minutes speaking of a personal reclamation, or rather a reclamation that is very near and dear to my heart ... and that is the reclamation of the teachings that I brought two thousand years ago. This reclamation can be achieved and the bridges can be made that will enable this reclamation.

The first distortion that I would like to dissipate is the concept that you need to me in order to save you.

My advice and my example may be useful to you. My advice and my example and my teachings may be guideposts, and I will be there to hold your hand, but it is you who would "save" yourself. It is the decisions you make and the kind of life you live that determines the outcome.

I came to bring information and truths to the human family of Earth, particularly my own portion of that family, the Jewish community. I did not come to be a sacrificial lamb for the sins of the entire of humanity. That was not my role ... that is not my role.

Members of the human family of Earth must work together and each must work for the whole and serve the good of the whole and when that happens, then you will begin to see the reclamation of the human family of Earth. I can promise you my role is not that kind of salvation. I am a teacher. I am a guide. I care a very great deal about the human family of Earth, but I cannot save you. This is something you must do yourselves.

I would like that to be clear. I would like to reclaim that clarity about my role. I brought the best wisdom I knew how. I asked my followers to look inside and understand that they are children of God, each and every one of them. And they each carve out their own relationship with God by carving out their relationships with their fellow human beings and with the planet in which they live.

I have a great deal of compassion for each and every, *every* human being. I would be a guide and teacher and have every one of you move forward in your own spiritual path. And I would have you listen to the wisdom that comes through in the messages I brought then and the messages I bring now. But please understand fully, completely and finally: I am not the savior

of this planet. I am not the savior of humanity. Humanity has the strength, the ability, the wisdom to save itself and that is what must happen.

We are coming as a team of elder brothers and sisters to assist as each and every one of you works to save humanity by creating a new civilization. So I will reclaim my role as a teacher, as a guide, as one who did his best to bring light, live in light and demonstrate love, did his best to encourage you to understand that you have the power within to begin reclaiming your own divinity. That is your power. Reclaiming your divinity is *your* power, not mine.

I, with my fellow elder brothers and sisters, work tirelessly to help you realize that this reclamation is a task that you must undertake. We will help you and guide you and advise you and cheer for you in every way we can, but not one of us is able to do this reclamation for you.
