



# Purpose, Intentions and Other Soul Commitments

This evening's topic is a dissertation on soul commitments.

Soul purpose I have covered under "Soul Purpose and Free Will" (Essay 11-01). That does not change. Soul purpose remains as explained, but after purpose we have words like intention, contract, agreement and each of these has ...

Well, you have these things called denotative and connotative meanings, and you have many authors using many different terms in many different ways.

I will explain the kind of commitment, the kind of relationship, and I will put a name to it. Then you can argue names and accurate names in any way you choose. But the *nature* of the commitment does not change. So I will give you the nature of the commitment and the name I would use, but please feel free to use your own name.

That is one of the difficulties about language. When people use one word to describe a commitment and others use a different word to describe the same commitment you run into misunderstandings, confusion, the Tower of Babel.

## **Soul Purpose Compared with Soul Intentions**

Soul purpose is slightly different from soul intentions.

Generally speaking, *soul purpose* is chosen for the soul's own growth. This can be karmic, can be expansion of consciousness, it can be preparation for future service. Those are the examples, but purpose is

for the soul's own growth. And that is why the ultimate purpose is to reunite with the Divine.

*Soul intention* is chosen as service to others. The more mature the soul, the more intention and purpose are likely to merge. This is a very subtle merging as reunification with the Divine becomes a means of service. And that is with a very, very advanced soul. Maybe even more advanced than the ascended masters, but it does happen. That is the path.

### **Purpose and Intention Blended**

The purpose for a specific life may be, as in an example I used earlier, to become the CEO of an international corporation.

The *purpose* of being a CEO may be to experience that kind of power and use it wisely. The *intention* may be to use that power in such a way that flexibility and respect for diversity are instilled throughout the organization.

The purpose (becoming CEO of an international company) could have been paired with a different intention, for example the intention to establish equity in pay and promotional opportunities from country to country.

The intention (to instill respect for diversity) could have been paired with a different purpose, for example the purpose to experience managerial challenges in a racially diverse location where prejudice is an issue.

### **Soul Contracts**

A contract is between a soul and the Hierarchy. An intention may become a contract.

If someone's intention is to instill respect for cultural diversity within an international organization rather than impose a single corporate model, we will make plans based on the fact that we expect this flexibility and respect for diversity to develop between Country A and Country B [due to the respectful business climate]. The intention becomes a contract and we make plans based upon the fact that this intention will be manifested as reality.

**Soul Agreement**

An agreement is between soul group and soul group or between individual soul and individual soul. The Hierarchy does not make plans based on fulfillment of an agreement. An agreement is a personal matter as it were.

An individual soul, let's take our CEO, may count on the fact that someone in his/her soul group is willing to make a private agreement to become the spouse and *de facto* partner in this arrangement. So let us make our CEO feminine.

**Intertwined Relationships**

Our CEO is a she and a soul in her soul group made an *agreement* to be her husband in this life. He agreed to choose a career where he could support her in this very demanding effort. So he made an agreement to travel freely; he made an agreement, perhaps, to limit their family to one child. He made an agreement then to study cultural anthropology and be her anthropological resource as she moves about internationally and rises up the corporation. Be that as it may, this is a personal agreement.

The *contract* is with the CEO. The contract is with her; the *agreement* is between her and another soul from her group to be the kind of support that she needs to fulfill the contract with the Hierarchy.

So *her* intentions became a contract. Her husband's intentions are to study anthropology etc., to be her ready resource on getting along in various countries. Maybe he is a very talented linguist so that he has many languages at his disposal.

His *intention* was to accumulate this kind of knowledge and be a ready, walking supportive reference for her as she fulfills her task. The skills list is designed to support her, but his intentions are not a Hierarchical contract. The Hierarchy is not making plans specifically based on his ability to fulfill his intentions.

**Summary**

Maybe the husband's *purpose* for this life is to take on and enjoy a non-traditional role. His *agreement* is to become the CEO's husband. His

*intention* is to master a list of skills which will help his wife achieve her ends.

So there are all these subtleties within these various relationships, various levels of soul commitments. There are multiple commitments and multiple directions. I have explained the differences and given a comparison between them.

This covers the topic. It is a bit short for an entire essay but I know of nothing else I wish to say on this matter.

I will close with my blessings upon you all. I wish you the very best in sorting out, if you choose to sort out: Purpose, Intentions, Agreements and Contracts.
