



The Ultimate Ascension

Reader's Question

Hi, My name's Jeff. In the essay *Ascension and Ascended Masters* (April 2011), Yeshua briefly refers to an "ultimate ascension." I was wondering if a question could be put to him about what exactly this ascension is and how it's caused. Thanks.

Yeshua's Response

Jeff, I thank you for this question.

This is a common question and there is much today that is spoken of about ascensions. If I were being unkind, I might say there is an ascension madness out there, but I will refrain from being unkind.

The fact is that the term ascension has come to mean quite different things to different groups. Different New Age movements have one definition of ascension and esoteric movements have another definition of ascension and spirituality groups of a different ilk have a different definition of ascension. This is something to be aware of.

However, and I smile here, you ask me for *my* definition and therefore that is what you shall have, *my* definition of ascension.

My definition of ascension is bound up with the evolution of the soul and it is based upon the knowledge – I will not say assumption – it is based upon the *knowledge* that the God-Spark within you, called by many the soul, begins a journey when it separates from the unity of the Divine, the Oneness that is the Divine.

You see, the Oneness is slightly different from the unity of the Divine. We *live* in Oneness, all, the entire of Creation energetically interlaced and interwoven, unable to escape from all the weavings that bind every single subatomic

particle to every other particle in the entire of Creation. Those are the energetic bonds of Oneness.

Unity, however, is ... I suppose you could call it a molecule, analogous to a molecule. But this molecule is a very special molecule, for it is so tightly joined that it no longer can be separated. Unity is a group brought together and held together so strongly that it becomes not the sum of the parts, but simply a unity of one.

I hope that is clear. The unity is one. If you read my commentary *On God* (June, 2011) you will get an idea what I speak of. I will summarize. A raindrop is water and it says, "I am water," and the raindrop falls in a lake. And the lake says, "I am water." The lake is a unity.

Now that unity may feed a river, which is its own unity, which flows to the ocean, which is its own unity. That's the concept of unity, which is different from Oneness.

Energetically, when this spark of the divine unity, this infinitesimal spark of that unity – let us think of a raindrop moving in reverse – when a spark of this divine unity leaves that unity, it has not left the Oneness. It is still a nodule in the Oneness, but it has left the unity and it begins its journey. And its journey takes it through many lives and many places and many experiences, and at some point that individual spark turns and begins to return to the unity from which it has come.

Each milestone along that path of return is an ascension, is an expansion of consciousness, is an expansion of spiritual education. There are many terms. Initiation is another term.

All these are terms for the spiritual milestones experienced on the path of return to the *ultimate* ascension, the ultimate graduation, the ultimate initiation – pick your term – and that is when that spark that left the unity eons and eons and eons ago returns and joins with that unity again, as a raindrop that moved through a puddle to a lake to a river to the ocean.

This spark that left the unity now returns to the unity. From within that unity, it contributes its total experience to the experience of the unity. *That is the ultimate ascension.*

And I am here to tell you that not one spiritual being on Earth is even close to that ultimate ascension. Each of us has many spiritual lessons yet to learn, many expansions of consciousness yet to experience. That ultimate ascension is where every single spark of God that lives within every incarnate human being is headed. That ultimate ascension is where those of us in the Community of Spiritual Masters are headed. That is the ultimate ascension,

that return – that full and total return – to the unity from which we separated eons and eons and eons and eons ago.

Thank you, Jeff for that question. I hope this has answered your need.

Before I leave, I would like to assure you, you and everyone else who takes the time to read this commentary, that every single milestone along the way – call it what you will, a graduation, an ascension, an initiation – every single milestone along the path of return is cause to celebrate, is an achievement, is progress in consciousness expansion, is an increase in the light that you bring to the Oneness of Creation.

Do not devalue any of these milestones because they don't happen to be the "ultimate." Value them for what they are, and value them for the light you are able to distribute every time you increase your consciousness, every time you increase your service to humanity, every time you learn more and bring what you have learned into your life and manifest that light on this physical plane. That is what is to be praised – the achievement.

The healthy view of an achievement is, "I reached that milestone. It is not a victory for me personally, it is a victory for the Oneness, because I am now able to share more of my light and more of my service with the rest of humanity, with the Oneness."

Every step of that way, every milestone helps heal the pain of Mother Earth. So those milestones are achievements in healing, are achievements in spreading light. Think of milestones that way, as a service rather than a personal achievement. That would be my recommendation.
